## NREMT Recertification Checklist and Timeline

### By August 1<sup>st</sup>

Review your CEU's to see what areas you are lacking in training and set up a plan to complete these hours with your crew.

### By January 1<sup>st</sup>

Log into the [www.nremt.org](http://www.nremt.org) website and set up your profile. Your agency affiliation is Summit Fire Authority. All questions can be answered in this [how-to-page](#).

Click on "Manage Your Profile" and make sure everything is correct and accurate.

Click on "Create New Application", choose you level of training and mark the box acknowledging you have read and understood the requirements.

Click on "My Certification". This is where you will need to enter your trainings from you SAHEMS report.

Choose "Manage Education" and enter each training record into your online application.

**\*Remember to enter more than 72 hours in case any are rejected.**

**\*\*Electives include: Teaching CPR training (12hr. max), Driver Training, ICS, Hazmat, Rope Rescue, Extrication, Crime Scene Awareness, MCI, Dispatch, and WMD Training. A maximum of 24 hours of electives can be used to meet the required 48 hours of CEUs.**

### By March 1<sup>st</sup>

RWB applicants must contact HCTC to receive a voucher number for payment. LDFR and CMFD applicants can submit for reimbursement.

Once all your 72+ hours of training entered, click on submit your application.

Email your department name, your supervising officer and a copy of your SAHEMS training hours report to [ejohnson@rwbfire.org](mailto:ejohnson@rwbfire.org)

Applications MUST be electronically submitted before the March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.

The HCTC will confirm hours, current CPR cert. on file, current ACLS cert. on file, obtain required signatures and submit application to NREMT.
